## Al Act: Key milestones since publication in the Official Journal



01 August 2024 Entry into force 02 May 2025

Availability of "Codes of Practice" for Al model providers

02 August 2026

24 months after entry into force

General applicability of the other regulations, for example innovation measures such as Al sandboxes 02 August 2030

72 months after entry into force

Obligations of providers and operators of high-risk Al systems intended for use by public authorities

The AI Act only applies to operators of high-risk AI systems that were placed on the market or put into operation within 24 force if these systems are changes to their design from that date onwards

**02 February 2025** 

6 months after entry into force

Applicability of Chapters I and II (General provisions, Prohibited AI systems)

02 August 2025

12 months after entry into force

Notification obligations, Al governance; regulations for Al models; confidentiality; fines and other enforcement measures

02 August 2027

36 months after entry into force

Obligations in relation to highrisk systems; obligations for CI model providers whose model was launched on the market 12 months before entry into force **31 December 2030** 

Obligations for Al systems that are part of large European (information) IT systems (e.g. Schengen Information System, Eurodac)
